Communication and Dissemination Plan Update RP1

CoDiet's Communication and Dissemination Plan (D8.1) was submitted in M6 (June 2023) and laid out the aims, target groups, core planned activities, and key performance indicators (KPIs) for CoDiet's communication and dissemination.

D8.1 was intended as a live document that can be adapted to the needs of the project as it develops, and as such we have reviewed D8.1 following the first 12 months of delivery.

Following review, we have found:

- The identified aims remain relevant and do not need to be changed.
- The identified target stakeholders and audiences remain relevant and do not need to be changed.
- The identified implementation approaches remain relevant and do not need to be changed.
- The identified KPIs remain relevant and do not need to be changed.

Since the submission of D8.1, WP8 Leads at Imperial College London have been implementing the plan through the communication and dissemination of materials through the project <u>website</u> and social media accounts (<u>X</u>; <u>LinkedIn</u>); <u>public events</u>; branded templates; and <u>open-access publications</u>.
